

Carpool Apps for Employers

This document provides a brief description and a Pros/Cons table for three different carpool apps that could potentially work for employers in Flagstaff.

Waze carpool: Carpool app that pairs drivers and riders with similar commutes to work or school so they can team up and ride together through the app. All payments are handled through the app. Unlike ridesharing apps like Uber or Lyft, Waze Carpool does not pay drivers or charge a commission on rides.

Pros:	Cons:
The total cost of the route is based on standard mileage rates and is divided by the amount of people sharing the ride.	There is no screening process to be a driver.
Waze currently waives all service fees, meaning they're not making a cent off of the transaction	Waze Carpool will only match a driver with passengers for 2 trips per day.
Very easy to sign up and use.	

Poolmyride: Pool My Ride is a carpooling app for verified corporate employees. Save Money | Save Time | Save Environment by connecting with people on the same route.

Pros:	Cons:
Poolmyride charges no money and is 100% free to use.	You do have to pay for a premium account to access certain features.
With a premium account you can search for rides by organization/LinkedIn.	
Chat with potential riders/drivers and view their profiles before sharing your contact information.	

Scoop: Scoop empowers organizations to get the most out of their hybrid work environments. It keeps track of employees schedules and arranges carpools when possible. It has multiple other HR functions besides Carpooling that could be useful for businesses.

Pros:	Cons:
Basic functions are free.	Enterprise functions are \$5 per user/Mo billed annually or \$6 billed monthly.
Connect employees going the same way in a safe, reliable, and convenient door-to-door carpool.
